

Canada

- The S&P/TSX Composite increased 0.64% on the week led by an increase of 3.36% in the Materials sector.
- Canadian manufacturing sales fell 1.6% in February as the auto sector faced a shortage of
 microchips that forced some assembly plants to ramp down production or shut down. Statistics
 Canada indicated that manufacturing totaled \$55.4 billion in February on lower sales of
 transportation equipment, offset in part by higher sales in the petroleum and coal product,
 chemical, and wood product industries.

United States

- The S&P/500 Composite increased 1.37% on the week.
- US consumer sentiment improved in April following another round of fiscal stimulus and as job
 growth accelerated. At the same time, inflation expectations surged to the highest in nine years.
 The University of Michigan's preliminary sentiment index rose to 86.5 from 84.9 in March and
 remains at a pandemic high. Overall consumers are more upbeat as the economic recovery
 strengthens. A surge in pent-up consumer demand is also expected to propel the US back to
 its pre-pandemic strength.
