

Canada

- The S&P/TSX Composite decreased 0.02% on the week led by a decrease of 4.14% in the Health Care sector.
- In April, the total value of all the goods and services produced in Canada's economy shrank for
 the first time since the start of the pandemic. Statistics Canada reported that Canada's gross
 domestic product (GDP) shrank by 0.3%, as a majority of industries had less output in April than
 the previous month.

United States

- The S&P/500 Composite increased 1.67% on the week.
- The pace of US hiring accelerated in June, with payrolls increasing by the most in 10 months, suggesting firms are having greater success recruiting workers to keep pace with the economy's reopening. Nonfarm payrolls jumped by 850,000 last month, bolstered by strong job gains in leisure and hospitality, according to the Labor Department.
