

Canada

- The S&P/TSX Composite increased 0.01% on the week led by an increase of 1.29% in the Consumer Discretionary sector.
- Canada's population rose by just 0.4% in 2020 to 38,048,738, according to Statistics Canada. That was the slowest annual growth since 1916, during World War I. In absolute numbers, the 149,461 annual increase was the smallest since 1945. A drop in international migration from closed borders was the main contributor. Canada recorded 184,624 immigrants in 2020, down by almost half from 2019. Also, more non-permanent residents left the country last year than came in, resulting in a loss of 86,535 people. That's the largest net loss of foreign residents such as workers and students on record.

United States

- The S&P/500 Composite decreased 0.77% on the week.
- US retail sales declined 3% in February, as cities across the US experienced sub-freezing temperatures and winter storms overwhelmed power grids in Texas and the Great Plains.
 Spending may have also been subdued because the Internal Revenue Service's tax filing window opened two weeks later than usual, delaying refunds. A report last week from the IRS showed a 3% year-over-year decline in refunds.
