



Canada

- The S&P/TSX Composite decreased 2.59% on the week, led by a decrease of 7.41% in the Materials sector.
- The Bloomberg Nanos Canadian Confidence Index, a measure of consumer sentiment, dropped to 54.3 last week, the lowest reading since December 2020. The numbers suggest the combination of rising prices, higher rates and the war in Ukraine is starting to weigh on consumers.

United States

- The S&P/500 Composite decreased 2.41% on the week.
- The University of Michigan's sentiment index (a consumer sentiment index) fell to 59.1 from 65.2 in April, marking the lowest consumer sentiment rating since 2011 amidst persistent concerns over inflation. American consumers expect prices to rise 5.4% over the next year, holding at a four-decade high for the third month in a row.
