

Canada

- The S&P/TSX Composite increased 1.05% for the week, led by a 4.32% increase in the Energy sector.
- The Bank of Canada held its policy rate steady for a fourth consecutive meeting and explicitly stated for the first time that it won't need to increase it again if the economy evolves in line with its forecasts

United States

- The S&P/500 Composite increased 1.06% for the week.
- US inflation rose 0.2% from November to December. Compared with a year ago, prices
 increased 2.6%. Excluding volatile food and energy costs, prices also rose just 0.2% from
 month to month. At the same time, the US economy expanded at a surprisingly strong 3.3%
 annual pace in the final three months of last year.
