#### Canada

- The S&P/TSX Composite increased 1.08% on the week, led by the Information Technology sector which increased 6.14%.
- Real GDP jumped 4.5% in May, the steepest monthly increase on record. Production rose in 17 of the 20 industrial sectors covered including construction (+17.6%), manufacturing (+7.4%), accommodation/food services (+24.2%) and retail (+16.6%).
- At the provincial level, business sentiment improved in Ontario (from 54.0 to 66.0), British Columbia (from 53.6 to 55.0), Alberta (from 55.7 to 58.1) and Quebec (from 38.1 to 39.6).

#### **United States**

- The S&P/500 Composite increased 1.73% on the week.
- Initial jobless claims totaled 1,434K in the week ended July 25, up from 1,422K the week before. Though small, the increase was still the second in a row after 15 straight declines. Since the beginning of the crisis, a whopping 54.1 million people have applied for unemployment benefits.
- Continuing claims, meanwhile, rose for the first time since May, climbing from 16,151K to 17,018K in the week to July 18. The total number of people receiving benefits in the week to July 18 was thus equivalent to 11.6% of the labour force.
